Hi Mrs Swan,

I hope this note finds everyone well. I have a new address of Prairie Du Chien. I still haven't moderated to minimum, even though I'm 5 yrs from MR. I guess I'm a hard case with 2 Bozus, minor tickets in 18 yrs.

I did get my program need expunged after 9 yrs, thanks to Mr Heise (Mark) (direct of Bureau of Classification and Movement). However, as soon as I left NLCI it seems like the momentum has stopped.

PDCI has much better food than NLCI; however the good list pretty well stops at food. Honestly, this place should either be down sized or closed.

There is a shortage of bathroom facilities here. They won't give out soap or tooth paste. Library is run by a Nazi and to make copies will need to be okayed by Gov Adolf himself (just kidding). It is very tight here, as bad as any MAX prison. Computer are in shortage and use is very strict. In short the place is a mess.

Presently, I'm in an E max cell. I do not see anything progressing well here. At some point I'm hoping to get some help from Mr Heise in Madison, however long shot that may be.

I will see parole in June, at the request of Mr Heise. Unfortunately, we have Emily Davidson as a commissioner. I truly think of her as someone of less than a sound mind. I guess she only needs to deny and be little to justify her \$60,000+ salary. Tax payers certainly are pipped off by WDOC.


I was sent back over to Dodge from NLCI to be transferred to PDCI. The temp-cells truly are nasty in every dimension. Upon visiting with other inmates, I've not heard anything good about Wise Secure Minimum prison. It's better to remain in medium.

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I was able to see my parents before leaving NLCI. My cousins were able to bring them in (bleatler). My parents are aging at the speed of light. My mother has very little mobility left. I had hopes of something happening when Mr. Heise took an interest in my case. After arriving here and having a conference with my social worker, the hope had been completely removed.

Ms. Swan, I have nothing else for now. I need to contact the other organizations of my address change. I hope you are enjoying the spring. Till later, take care.
