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3	10	04-14-2015: In Ms. LaCost Action Statement she made the ludicrous statement that my Program Participation was NOT satisfactory: This is a false statement:
4	11	10-13-2015: This day, at age 72, I experienced 44 Birthdays in prison since 1969: I wake up each morning with a sense of dread and foreboding, It is so problematic and difficult to function while so very depressed: Page 2 ... It is made abundantly clear in my Clinical Service File that the psychiatry evaluations thereof are categorically 100% accurate with expertise: Having said this, the Wisconsin DOC [system] should share a significant amount of responsibility [blame] for my criminal behavior due to the fact they denied me adequate treatment and prematurely released me from prison while I remained trapped in a vicious deviate cycle, thus my fate of doom was inevitable. Page 4 ... The SCI Administration remains focused on "punishment" and NOT on rehabilitation goals of prisoners, and "only" on "warehousing" of inmates:
5	12	1-29-2016: Signing of "waiver" of parole consideration for 2016, [In silent protest]. Page 2 ... Potential "input" [two pages] for March 2016 parole hearing. However, these are made moot since I signed the waiver, so no review will happen. Page 4 ... Form- 9 Document showing "only" 6 minor Conduct Reports in 25 years:
2	13	1-04-2016: Letter to Mr. Hsise, Bureau of Classification/Movement; and his response:
8	14	My published true life story in "Adventured In Hell" depicts the tragic story about my Vietnamese common-law-wife, <i>Tuyet Hoa</i> , who gave birth to my Amerasian child <i>Nha</i> , and was brutally murdered by the <i>Viet Cong</i> as a terrorist act for her fraternization with an American soldier (me). You will see the effects of war on the soul of this war veteran in this story, etc.
2	15	The veteran reflects back to his PTSD as a "war nurosis" with an identity disturbance: I was a good person whose lifelong worth was lost to our society due to my military service. I fight hard to get my mind back inside my hear, and out of <i>Viet Nam</i> .
