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Dear Pegi,

I believe it was reported by you in FFUP and in the popular media (either or both The Milwaukee Journal Sentinel and Wisconsin Public Radio) that segregation time has capped at 90 days, per policy. It hasn't.

We recently had fifteen guys from our living unit placed in solitary confinement from an incident (see enclosed conduct report). All of them, from my understanding, received 120 days or 180 days of disciplinary separation (i.e. segregation time).

I know segregation is something you are working on. I do not know anyone who has seen a written policy capping segregation time to 90 days. In fact, the Wisconsin Administrative Code DOC 303 allows for disciplinary separation for up to 360 days.

I told Jose Diaz to send me copies, but they sent me originals. This place will not allow me to make copies of his paper work, therefore you get the originals.
