

on 8-18-2016 I were placed into observation status on suicide watch, Do to me being extremely depressed and traumatized Do to A ordeal that took place while I were at green Bay hospital for overdosing. Do to being so depressed I stop eating for five days, nor did I drink any thing. So the Doctor put me on the ensure with every meal. So I only drank (the ensure), the at Breakfast, the for lunch and dinner. I drank the ensures for five weeks, I were on hunger strike for ~~one~~ six weeks while I were on suicide watch. Do to the hunger strike I lost (30 pounds).

~~While~~ I were on observation status still, on 9-24-2016 per B-204 were gas. So I ask to be pulled out, Do to complications Breathing, because of gas. So then co. Barbeau and Sgt. Klemmer took me to a shower stall on upper range. When I asked these Co's to loosen up my leg shackles, Sgt. Klemmer told me ~~to step into the shower~~ ~~and slightly pushed me into the shower~~ not to push back. I said im not pushing back, im asking A question. Then Sgt. Klemmer said step into the shower and slightly pushed me. So I walked into the shower stall. Then I cursed Sgt Klemmer out for pushing me. after that the Sgt. who were running the unit that day his name is Sgt. Cushing. He came up with the nurse asking were I okay, I said yes. Then I asked Sgt. Cushing not to send Sgt. Klemmer back to get me Do to me using him out I feared for my safety because I know Sgt Klemmer has A history for assaulting inmates in reg. while they are in restraints. He slammed A inmate in his face knocking his tooth out his mouth. When I ask Sgt. Cushing not to send Sgt. Klemmer back up to get me he said in an angry tone, whoever I send up to get you is who I send. So me knowing how Cushing is I knew he were going to send Sgt Klemmer back to get me. And he did so. A short time after Sgt Klemmer and Sgt. Nelson came to take me back to my cell but I told them im not coming. They said yes you are. Instead of following protocol

which is to go get Sgt. Cushing to come talk to me. Then
if I don't come out Sgt. Cushing have to call his
supervisor which is the white shirt. But instead
they opened the shower stall door and dragged me out
of the shower stall. They forced me to walk by pushing
me to walk faster, in leg restraints, trying not
to get hurt (falling down stairs, or being hurt by
CO's I started to kneel down.
