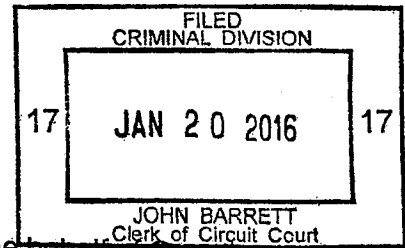
Dear Judge,

I am writing this letter in the hopes that it will help you to see what kind of person **Quinten Cherry** is, despite the transgressions that led us all to this point.



Thank you for considering this request for leniency.

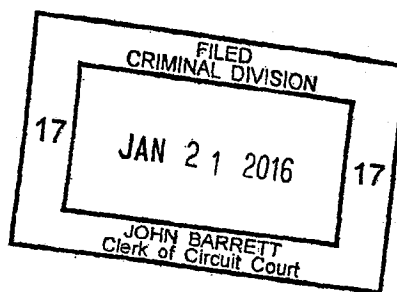

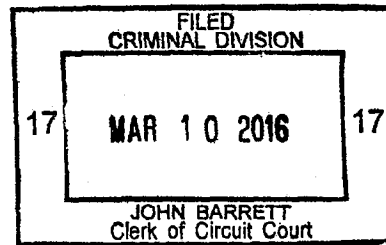
