According to the record, this offense involved Mr. Toth stabbing a man to death in the parking lot of a gas station. Reports note that the victim was stabbed twice in the chest, 3 times in the back and had his neck cut. There were also a number of cuts and abrasions to the hands, arms and head, indicating defensive wounds as he fought off the attack.

The offense involved an adult male victim agreeing to sell Mr. Toth rock cocaine, giving him six \$10 to \$20 bags. When the victim asked for payment, Mr. Toth told him he would pay him next payday. The victim became angry and threatened Mr. Toth's family, resulting in him stabbing the victim approximately 8 times (according to PSI) with a knife. Mr. Toth stated he had the knife to make partial payment to the victim for the cocaine.

Motivation: He stated that at the time he felt that he and his family's lives were in jeopardy. He was using cocaine at the time and he felt paranoid.

Attitude: He feels horrible for committing the crime and states that it was unnecessary. He deals with the guilt he feels daily for committing the crime.

When it comes to substance use, I have changed all that. I now live a clean lifestyle. Sobriety is a top priority for me. I have made the necessary changes to keep my life on a positive track. I will see the parole commissioner next June and based on his comments, anticipate recommendation for minimum. In addition, I will be receiving my Associates degree in Liberal Arts from Indiana University. I would like to stay at RGCI until I see Parole again and/or get Minimum custody.

Staff Appraisal and Recommendations (Pre-Hearing)

This is a scheduled 12 month recall to review custody level, institution placement and program treatment needs. Mr. Toth will see the Committee. Mr. Toth will see the Committee and ask for Minimum even though he knows Parole has to recommend it.

Case plan was reviewed and updated to reflect LRI for SUD1. Mr. Toth completed Low Risk Interventions: Carey Guide: Substance Abuse, AODA New Freedom-Becoming a Stronger Person: Readiness for Change and AODA New Freedom-Becoming a Stronger Person: Getting It Right This Time.

WICS Program Plan also reflects completions of these. Current Job Assignment: G Unit Tutor 4 Full Time. He indicates he tutors approximately 20 people on all of G Unit. Some inmates are Spanish speaking and he is learning Spanish to better assist those inmates with their educational needs. His job entails tutoring for many subject areas, including areas outside of the regular GED/HSED requirements. He also reported that he keeps in contact with the Educational Department for any extra assistance he may need to assist inmates with their needs. He takes pride in doing his job well and if he doesn't know something, he will ask and try to figure it out. To his credit, he is even more goal directed, optimistic and future oriented despite his circumstances with a Life Sentence.

Mr. Toth continues to be future oriented with his college courses, tutoring, mentoring, being a role model and helping those who need it. His conduct record indicates excellent adjustment since 2003. No problems or concerns are noted by staff and his work evaluations are excellent. He demonstrates purpose to his life by taking very difficult college courses, tutoring, mentoring, being a role model and helping those who need it. Overall he seems optimistic, demonstrates excellent adjustment and uses coping strategies when difficult situations arise. There is evidence of a strong support system as his parents visit twice per week and they help with the cost of his college education. Understandably, he would like to go to a minimum, however, without an endorsement from Parole it would seem unlikely. It is noted that in 2012 he received a D-48, in 2015 a D-24 and most recently a D-18 on 12/15/17. Therefore, this social worker recommends medium custody and retention at RGCI.

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Committee Comments

This review was conducted pursuant to WI Administrative Code 302, and addresses custody, site placement and program assignments.

This is a scheduled review. Mr. Toth arrived at RGCI on 01/26/05 from GBCI. At age 49, Mr. Toth is serving his 1st incarceration as a New Admit. Mr. Toth is serving a life sentence for offense of 1st Degree Intentional Homicide. Parole Commission gave Mr. Toth a D-18 with a new PED of 08/22/2019. His previous defer was 24 months.

He has no pending charges, SPNS, Escape, or STG affiliation.

Per ss. DOC 302.07 & 302.09, the committee unanimously recommends continued medium custody with placement at OSCI, KMCI, or FLCI. Institution adjustment has remained positive with no additional conduct reports this review period. His conduct is very good overall noting his last Major Conduct report was over 15 years ago which was prior to arrival at RGCI. He has shown program motivation with completion of all assigned programming. He maintained institution work assignments with positive evaluations.

The Committee agrees additional monitoring at current custody level is appropriate based on the heightened risk associated with his assaultive offense dynamics, latest parole action, and lengthy sentence structure. A custody reduction with such a significant amount of time remaining to serve would create an unreasonable amount of risk when considering the dynamics of his offense. Mr. Toth's behavior is indicative of his ability to handle the responsibilities that come with monitoring at this level.

In regards to placement, the Committee agrees a change of placement is needed based on the lengthy time incarcerated at RGCI. He has been at RGCI since 01/26/05. Mr. Toth is encouraged to maintain positive adjustment and take advantage of any volunteer opportunities available to him at RGCI.

A 12 month recall has been set. No significant changes affecting custody are expected prior to his next recall.

Inmate may request an Administrative Review of the Classification decision pursuant to DOC 302.19 by filing a current DOC-1292 (Rev. 7/2018) Administrative Review of Classification Decision form within 10 days of receipt of the final decision. Administrative Reviews are based on erroneous information, not disagreement with custody and/or placement recommendation.
