I got the News Letter you sent me and I was very pleased with the information it gives out. Prisoners like myself and I shared it with others here at Ashkosh Correctional Institution on my unit Ms. Swan.

The issues here contain Small breakfast, such as toast, Cereal, Peanut Butter, Jelly, 1 glass of milk for each ~~per~~ person in the morning and juice.

The way I see the problem why they cannot keep new guards for a long time; they see how we are getting treat, so next thing is their gone.

I would have to say that youth person guards got away with a slap on the hand, they swear out loud at us. The ICT are mainly reject bay the prison when we fall one out, because in the end they are Dismissed without an investigation.

I am on "K-unit and we are the last unit to get feed, The food is quality made, for they keep taking each meal and cut back on them every day.

I've been to Seven Institutions in the 21.5 years and seen the parole board I would have to say at least 7 or 8 times. I been sent out of state in 1998 4.5 years.

7 months in Waupun, 5 years at Redgrante, 2.5 years at WRL, then 2 years at BSCI, and now I have been here at Oshkosh just over 5 years. And in that time I personally had been to Mercury Hospital 3 times, I am only 59 years and I'm already have to use a cane to get around, pretty soon I will have to use the walker for the winter.

I wish Tony Evers would come to Oshkosh and see how things are, because we are still considered as modify lockdown.

I am going let go for now, and it was good to hear about things out there thanks!
