Disabilites prevent employment, exercise minimal health care, i.e., Broken/dislocating (Hill-Sachs-Lesion) Left Shoulder for over 1 year; Incontinence, Customized Bunk, Pain medication, Anxiety Medication; Sleep Medication, PTSD Treatment, Mattress, Neurosurgery; Hyperparathyroidism Symptomology Treatment, Fibromyalgia Treatment, etc. without current Litigation - U.S. Dist. Ct., Eastern Dist. Case No. 17-C-1493 U.S. Dist. Case No. 17-OCR-1557. Both current and pending.
