(11) Explain circumstances of crime.

All my crimes happened on 3-1-1987. I was a plumber who owned his own business. My wife handled all the book keeping. She neglected to pay any of my plumbing suppliers for (3) months. My suppliers contacted me personally about them not receiving any payment. I discussed this problem with my wife and she said all the money is gone. She got huffy and left, then filed for divorce. Three months later she came begging me for a job for extra money for Christmas. I allowed her to work (2) days. During those working days she made photo copies of my account receiveables files. Then about (3) months later my customers start calling me saying a short lady was trying to collect money owed to my plumbing business. So on March 1-1987 I had a hard day at work. I had some beers, then went to my wife trailer. Broke into it, look for the files she had. I could not find them so I figured if I could not have them neither will she. So I set fire to her bedroom. Just as I started the fire I was confronted by my step-daughter. I panicked and hit her, some 19 days ^{later} she passed away. I was arrested on March 2, 1987, convicted and sentenced on Nov. 2-1987. I have now served (33) years incarcerated. My (PED) Parole eligibility date was after I had served (23) years and (4) months to become eligible for parole in 2010. I have seen Parole (5) times now, My last time I received a (10) month defer, so in January 24, 2021 I will see Parole again. I am still medium custody because the parole commissioner said I have not done enough time for my crime. On April 23, 2020 I am scheduled to see P.R.C., I am requesting consideration for endorsement for minimum custody and be transfer to Oakhill Corr. Insti. Medical center.

(12) Extraordinary Circumstances.

I fear for my safety because of the COVID -19 Virus that will enter Stanley Correctional Institution and infect me. I am (77) years old, I have C.O.P.D. and use Symbicort Daily. I also have allergys that effects my breathing. I am considered a HIGH RISK of getting COVID-19 and dying from the virus. Due to my old age, fragile health, my uncurable prostate cancer I have been battling for (3) years (3) months. The Urologist Doctor Johnson wrote a letter discribing the diagnosis and prognosis of my cancer and gave me 2-5 years to live. I have already lived (3) years, so I have a short time to live. I also have high blood pressure which is treated with lisinopril medication. On 12-10-2019 I had a X-Ray of my left hip because of all the pain I am Having. The results shows that I now have oeteoarthritis. The pain is so great that I now take 15mg. Morphine and 1000mg Acetaminophen (2) times daily. Even with the pain pills, the pain is still above the (10) level everyday. This COVID-19 Virus is the worst known to medical professionals. Sure think we are safe in Stanley prison, but

all it takes is (1) officer or staff with the virus and that is the begging of the end for me.

With all my disabilities which are; Special needs and Doctor Hannuls (HSU) have place me in a wheelchaie or walker. I can onlt walk about (100) feet at any given time before I have to rest. Also they have place a "NO WORK RESTRICTION on my files. I have a CARE TAKER who bring my meals to the table, Dresses me, Pushes my wheelchair to HSU for medication and appointments, and for all the other passes, and finally cleans my cell.

I am not a risk to society because I can not walk, run, jump, or climb or exercise. Because of all the pain I am in is so great I do not need to create more pain in my life.

My (PSA) blood test for cancer continue to raise by (20) points the past (3) months, and that is a hugh jump in numbers.

Another reason to consider is Male Lifer's compaired to all other imates has the lowert residivism rate, even of the women inmates.

My oldest daughter told me that I will be living with her, so that is where I will be living.

I feel rehilitated by taking all my D.O.C. needs programs.

I am very remorseful and have admitted doing the crime. I hope that the Governor feels I deserve a second chance at redemption and changing my life.

We have no hand sanitizer for the COVID-19 Virus. We get hand bar hand washing soap and that's it. We get a water down cleaning solution for cleaning our cells whenever we can. The solution is ECOLAB, Oasis # 499 disinfection, For Emergency Call 1-88-328-0026 it says on the spray bottle.

All the inmates on Unit 5-a-b-c- express thier fears and thoughts about the Doctors, Nurses, Staff, officers that are not checked upon entering this institution for a temperature check, ask about any acks or pains, Headacks, loss of taste or smell in order to protect the health and welfare and safety of all the inmates here at Stanley.

Thank you for reading what all I have indured these past (33) years.
