I took a plea in Rock County to spare my daughters having to testify again and because my lawyer told me that other Acts evidence of my web browser history would probably prejudice the jury and risk a guilty verdict. I am actually innocent of this crime. I have a pending State Habeas Corpus petition filed in the court of appeals. (~~I~~ took the Plea for 5 YEARS IN, and the End result I got 12 YRS?)

I was diagnosed at one point with stage 4 liver cancer.

I HAVE EXTREMELY HIGH LEVELS OF AMONIA IN MY BLOOD. (Coma Possible)

I have a heart condition. I am only seeking commutation

so that I can leave prison. This pandemic puts me at risk of fatal complications if I am infected with the COVID-19 virus. I cannot social distance to protect myself. I had family that will give me a place to live and support me financially.
