I was living in my brothers basement. My brothers wife's daughter who was 14 years old would also stay with us. I started having unhealthy thoughts and after about 4 months I gave in to my impulses and I started having (sex with her despited her age. The more involved I got in the situtation the more excuses I made to myself to justify what I was doing. I committed these crimes because I put my own selfish needs above what is morally right. I didn't stop and think about the psychological impact my actions would have on the victim and her family. I have had six years of incarceration to think about what I have done and I can't believe that I committed these acts against my victim.

12. Explain the extraordinary circumstances that you believe warrant a waiver of the Governor's eligibility rules. For example, an extraordinary circumstance could be, but is not necessarily, the fact that the conviction prohibits you from obtaining specific employment. However, the desire to hunt or possess a firearm for hunting purposes does not constitute extraordinary circumstances.

I am extremely vulnerable to the impact of the corona virus because of my health condition. I have a history of asthma for which I need a inhaler to help with my breathing, if I contrated the corona virus it would be devastating. If the virus would get inside the prison, there would be a greater chance of me contracting it due to the way the prison is set up. I am in daily contact with hundreds of people, it is impossible for me to social distance like people that are not incarcerated. I am not asking for a pardon, I am asking that my sentence be commuted to time served and the rest of the time that I have left to serve be added to my extended supervision. Due to overcrowding there are more and more individuals who are unable to get into their sex offender treatment programs and the prison is having them take the programs when they are released. I would be willing to take any programs deemed necessary while on extended supervision and will comply with any other terms of my release.
