And Now Due to the Covid Virus 19 Issue I am at risk due to the Motorcycle Accident that left me with a Compromised Lung that was punctured & collapsed at that time and A.T.B.I. also all of Prisoners are in a Compromised situation and our immune systems are all at risk being incarcerated. I am a Non-violent offender sitting in a Maximum Security with None of these programs available. I am eligible for the Challenge program thru the state also Court said & ordered I could have Huber in my hometown in Durand, WI, Dodge County Jail they have programs & Huber & treatment for support I was also eligible 3/1/20 (parole) for parole. I would more productive to do so. our prisons in this state are overcrowded. So Help state are lessening my sentence to home
