Secondly, if you read my emails to you, you will see that I would like to go back to C.C.I. Let me explain why then consider the facts I explain to you. First, I'm a "lifer" with first chance for parole in the year "2104". I've accepted my time and that I'm doing time and time is not doing me.

In my 26 yrs at C.C.I. (Columbia Corr. Inst.) Not one time that I ever had a dirty urinalysis. Not once ever solicited any staff. In 26 yrs of my incarcerated time, I only received "one" major conduct report for

Fighting. (Not at C.C.I., but at W.R.C.) Wisconsin Resource Center. Now with my time structure, I was in a single cell and working in R.H.I. The staff at C.C.I. has stated that I'm a "Role Model Inmate."

So therefore, the question should be asked: "Why did they send me here to Stanley Corr. Inst.?" Also, I didn't want to leave C.C.I. In 1993 at Dodge Corr. Inst. Staff stated that C.C.I. is a good place for me to do my time. I took upon myself and stated that C.C.I. will be my home until my passing. Also, while I was there at C.C.I. I kept telling the young inmates that this is not the place to be at. Meaning, get your life together! Playtime is over. Keep doing what you do, and you will find yourselves doing many, many years in prison.

Ms. Swan, I have obtain my H.S.E.D in 2014 at W.R.C and many other programs as well. Due to all the bad things ~~happening~~ ^{oops!} happening at C.C.I., I just feel the need to be there. To help others to stop fighting staff and so forth I hope that you can talk to the right individual or individuals, to help me live out the rest of my days at C.C.I. Hope to hear from you soon.
