On September 16, 1982, the Court inquired of the defendant why sentence should not be pronounced, and no sufficient grounds to the contrary being shown or appearing to the Court, the Court having accorded the district attorney, defense counsel, and the defendant an opportunity to address the Court regarding sentence; and upon all the evidence, records and proceedings, the Court pronounced Judgment as follows:

IT IS ADJUDGED that the defendant is convicted as found guilty, and is sentenced to the Wisconsin State Prisons for an indeterminate term of not more than LIFE IN PRISON. ~~(Court advised by defense counsel that defendant has received threats from Jorge Garcia, an inmate at Waupun, and request a Court order to keep defendant separated from the Cuban population at Waupun. Court ordered a transcript of this hearing forwarded to Waupun.)~~

IT IS ADJUDGED that 194 days sentence credit are due pursuant to Sec. 973.155, Wis. Stats.

IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk deliver a duplicate original of this Judgment to the Sheriff, and that the Sheriff shall forthwith deliver the defendant and a copy of this Judgment to the Waupun Correctional Institution (Reception Center) located in the City of Waupun

Warning: Any statement you make may be used against you in removal proceedings.

Alien Registration: This copy of the Notice to Appear served upon you is evidence of your alien registration while you are under removal proceedings. You are required to carry it with you at all times.

Representation: If you so choose, you may be represented in this proceeding, at no expense to the Government, by an attorney or other individual authorized and qualified to represent persons before the Executive Office for Immigration Review, pursuant to 8 CFR 3.16. Unless you so request, no hearing will be scheduled earlier than ten days from the date of this notice, to allow you sufficient time to secure counsel. A list of qualified attorneys and organizations who may be available to represent you at no cost will be provided with this Notice.

Conduct of the hearing: At the time of your hearing, you should bring with you any affidavits or other documents which you desire to have considered in connection with your case. If any document is in a foreign language, you must bring the original and a certified English translation of the document. If you wish to have the testimony of any witnesses considered, you should arrange to have such witnesses present at the hearing.

At your hearing you will be given the opportunity to admit or deny any or all of the allegations in the Notice to Appear and that you are inadmissible or deportable on the charges contained in the Notice to Appear. You will have an opportunity to present evidence on your own behalf, to examine any evidence presented by the Government, to object, on proper legal grounds, to the receipt of evidence and to cross examine any witnesses presented by the Government.

You will be advised by the immigration judge before whom you appear, of any relief from removal for which you may appear eligible including the privilege of departing voluntarily. You will be given a reasonable opportunity to make any such application to the immigration judge.

Failure to appear: You are required to provide the INS, in writing, with your full mailing address and telephone number. You must notify the Immigration Court immediately by using Form EOIR-33 whenever you change your address or telephone number during the course of this proceeding. You will be provided with a copy of this form. Notices of hearing will be mailed to this address. If you do not submit Form EOIR-33 and do not otherwise provide an address at which you may be reached during proceedings, then the Government shall not be required to provide you with written notice of your hearing. If you fail to attend the hearing at the time and place designated on this notice, or any date and time later directed by the Immigration Court, a removal order may be made by the immigration judge in your absence, and you may be arrested and detained by the INS.

Request for Prompt Hearing

To expedite a determination in my case, I request an immediate hearing. I waive my right to have a 10-day period prior to appearing before an immigration judge.

4. You were, on 09/16/82, convicted in the Milwaukee County Circuit Court Branch 22, Wisconsin for the offense of First Degree Murder, in violation of 940.01, Wisconsin Statutes;
5. You were sentenced to a term of imprisonment of life in prison.

On the basis of the foregoing, it is charged that you are subject to removal from the United States pursuant to the following provision(s) of law:

Section 237(a)(2)(A)(iii) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (Act), as amended, in that, at any time after admission, you have been convicted of an aggravated felony as defined in Section 101(a)(43)(F) of the Act, a crime of violence (as defined in section 16 of Title 18, United States Code, but not including a purely political offense) for which the term of imprisonment ordered is at least one year.
