

To whom it may concern:

My name is Wesley Hair, an inmate currently being held at Oshkosh Correctional Institution, and I am writing in concern to myself and others like me are being treated while in care of the state. I was at Winnebago center and tested negative. When I arrived at the institution I had completed a 15 day Quarantine period at R H U building at Oshkosh CI. At which time I had completed a total of two testings for COVID-19 one of which was done by the National Guard of Wisconsin, and both came back negative. After my hold time of 45 days I was placed in X-building, which is a barracks style intake unit for the prison. I had followed every precaution I was instructed to do by all staff and 30 days later the institution started to be infected with COVID-19 and was a mass test for all inmates, for my third test. The test had come back on 10-5-2020 around 6: PM and I was informed of having a positive result. At which time I was moved to a different section of the building and was ordered not instructed but ordered to remain in my bunk and not leave for fear of infecting others. At the time of this incident all positive results were told that no one was to use the phone and kiosk. We were not allowed to shower and barely allowed to use the bathroom we were restricted from using the day rooms and the

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They didn't let us sit at the tables or even write letters. All activity's between inmates was to cease immediately. The following is a complete list of what we as prisoners were told or given as orders during this event.

So everything that is on the news is a lie. This place has over 650 cases of positive cases of covid-19 and they are doing nothing but houseing use all together.

- According to HCU staff at OSC1 "the institution will not test prisoners again for covid-19 due to lack of supplies" verbatim:

- Restricted from going outside for fresh air and sunlight which is still in effect.
- Unable to practice social distancing due to bunks being no further than 3 ft. apart.
- ventilation of the building is highly improper.
- any ability to gather information is revoked and denied.
- phones denied and turned of by security : reinstated 10/6/2020
- kiosk denied : reinstated 10/6/2020
- incorrect supplies to properly clean and sanitize ourselves and our living quarters of covid-19.
- unless an order for mass testing again all request for a secondary test is denied.
- any information given to prisoners by HCU is to be believed wether correct or incorrect.
- prisoners have been denied laundry for over two weeks.
- staff shows no concern for the well being of any prisoners and is quick to hand out minor conduct reports in order to move us out of their way.
- Staff is not wearing their masks properly
- Staff doesn't believe that they are responsible for our well being.
- Staff doesn't believe it is their problem that inmates are catching covid-19.
