ALTHOUGH I HAD SENT MY INFO TO THE COMMUNITY TO FILE FOR ME, BUT TO BE ON THE SAFE SIDE, I FILLED OUT THE PAPER FORM THAT I HAD RECEIVED IN THE MAIL.

I PLAN TO SEEK RELEASE AFTER I GET COPIES OF MY MEDICAL RECORDS. THE STATE PUBLIC DEFENDER OFFICE IS HELPING INMATES PUT THE PAPER WORK TOGETHER. I AM SCHEDULED TO REVIEW MY MEDICAL RECORDS SOME NEXT MONTH AND SEND SAME TO THE PUBLIC DEFENDER TO SEE WHETHER I QUALIFY.

WITH THE VIRUS RUNNING THROUGH WISCONSIN'S PRISONS LIKE THE WILD FIRES OUT WEST, IF YOU COMPLAIN ANY ACHES OR PAIN, HSU TREAT IT AS A SYMPTOM OF THE VIRUS AND YOU ARE PUT IN QUARANTINE FOR EITHER 14 DAYS OR UNTIL THE TEST RESULTS COME BACK. HSU ~~THE~~ TAKE THE VIRUS SERIOUSLY AND TREATMENT IS GOOD.

BOTH STAFF AND INMATES WEAR FACE MASKS. WHILE ALL PROGRAMS ARE PUT ON HOLD, WE DO HAVE ACCESS TO DAY ROOM, PHONES, AND DAILY SHOWERS. FOR THE MOST PART, YOU JUST CAN'T LEAVE THE UNIT, BUT YOU CAN GO OUTSIDE IN THE COURT YARD AND

we eat in our rooms. They are trying to keep us safe
and if you're not feeling well, the unit staff will
call HSL and they will come within an hour and test
you for the virus and put you in quarantine for
either 14 days or until the test results come back.

Well, Peggy, I'll close now and I hope the
instruction sheet might benefit the inmates. Thank
you for reaching out. Be safe and stay well.
